



S. C. Code Ann. Section 11-35-4230(6) states, in pertinent part, that

[a] decision under subsection (4) of this section shall be final and conclusive, unless fraudulent, or unless any person adversely affected requests a further administrative review by the Procurement Review Panel under Section 11-35-4410(1) within ten working days of the posting of the decision in accordance with Section 11-35-4230(5).

The CPO posted the decision in this case on June 17, 1996, and the postmark on the envelope containing Triad's request for review by the Panel is postmarked July 2, 1996, which is more than ten working days from the date of posting of the decision. Triad's request for review by the Panel is not timely filed as required by the law, and therefore the Panel does not have jurisdiction to review the merits of the case. The Panel finds that Triad's letter is untimely filed and dismisses Triad's request for review by the Panel for lack of jurisdiction.
